POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Young Invincibles (YI) is the national young adult research and advocacy group, working to amplify the voices of young adults in the political process and expand economic opportunity for our generation. YI seeks a campus organizing fellow in Grand Forks, ND. Tapping into the national #VoteTogether initiative, this position will organize three non-partisan parties-at-the-polls on and before Election Day, driving University of North Dakota students to the polls. This position will oversee outreach and training for volunteers associated with the events as well as organize the logistics such as food, entertainment, and promotion. The duration of this fellowship will run for three months from August 13, 2018 to November 13, 2018.

- Solicit in-kind donations for food and entertainment as needed
